- **Connection** (1 Peter 4-5): "*He cares*" Christianity can be defined as being connected to God and people
- **Destiny** (2 Peter 1-2): Today's Topic!

1. Introduction to 2 Peter

- The final words of Peter, written ~65 AD from Rome to a more general audience without the help of Silas as he waited for his crucifixion
- o Facing death, what's on Peter's heart? I must soon leave this earthly life (1:14)

• Warnings that Parallel Jude

- Keep Growing: Don't stagnate (2 Peter 1:5-11 | Jude 3-4)
- Guard the Gospel: Avoid false teachers (2 Peter 2:1, 3:3-4 | Jude 4-13)
- o Prepare for the Day of the Lord (2 Peter 3:1-10 | Jude 6)
- Live a holy life (2 Peter 3:11-15 | Jude 20-23)
- Be on your guard (2 Peter 3:17-18 | Jude 24-25)
- Simon Peter, a **slave** (Gk: doulos) and apostle of Jesus Christ
 - Doulos someone who belongs to another; a bond-slave, without any ownership rights of their own.
- Grace and peace be yours in abundance...
 - o Greek: Greetings = "chairein" | grace = "charis"
 - O Hebrew: Peace = "shalom" | same as "greetings"
- His divine power... participate in the divine nature... escape the corruption of the world
 - What is God's power to overcome the sinful nature?

2. The Goodness of Growing

- The foundation we build on must be our faith in Jesus
- Without faith it is impossible to please God... and it warps our character

Character	With Faith, we will see	Without Faith, we will be
Goodness	Virtue in Action	Self-Righteous
Knowledge	Right Thinking	Puffed Up
Self-control	Spirit-led Temperance	Robotically Legalistic
Perseverance	Passionately Patient	Gutting it Out
Godliness	Worshipful Imitation	Burdened with Duty
Brotherly Kindness	Rich Relationships	Buddies not Brothers
Love	An Extension of God's Love	Burned Out

3. First Warning (2 Peter 1) - Hold to God's Plan!

- Never stop growing... or you will forget (v9-11)
 - Growth doesn't have to be intimidating
 - Stay headed in the right direction
 - Growth helps us keep our perspective
 - Nearsighted not problem-focused
 - Blind can't see God working
 - Growth helps you recover when you stumble
 - Keeps you focused on heaven
- Remember Jesus now... because we won't be here forever (v12-15)
- Get your facts straight... this is an eyewitness account (v16-18)
- This is God's voice... listen closely! (v19-21)

4. Second Warning: Beware of False Teachers (2 Peter 2)

- What are these false teachings?
 - Heresies (v1)
 - Doctrines that compromise obedience to the word of God
 - Depraved conduct (v2)
 - Tolerating sin instead of imitating Jesus; carousing (v14)
 - Greed (v3)
 - A health/wealth gospel that promises selfish gain
 - Fabricated stories (v3)
 - Hyping superstitions, "miracles," "signs," and "powers"
- Three Examples: Noah, Lot, and the Angels
- What is the outcome of heresy?
 - o **PRIDE:** So bold and arrogant they slandered angels (10)
 - **TRICKED:** They promised freedom but become slaves (19)
 - LOST: They escaped corruption but were once again overcome (20)
 - They knew our Lord and Savior Jesus Christ
 - They became entangled in the world again

5. Conclusion: Grow Into Your Destiny

- God gives us His Divine Power and His Divine Nature through the Holy Spirit!
- God's plan is to grow our faith into "goodness, knowledge, self-control, perseverance, godliness, brotherly kindness, and love"
- Our challenge: overcome the obstacles to growth
 - Never compromise your calling
 - Keep your eyes on your inheritance
 - Reject false teachers and false teaching
